

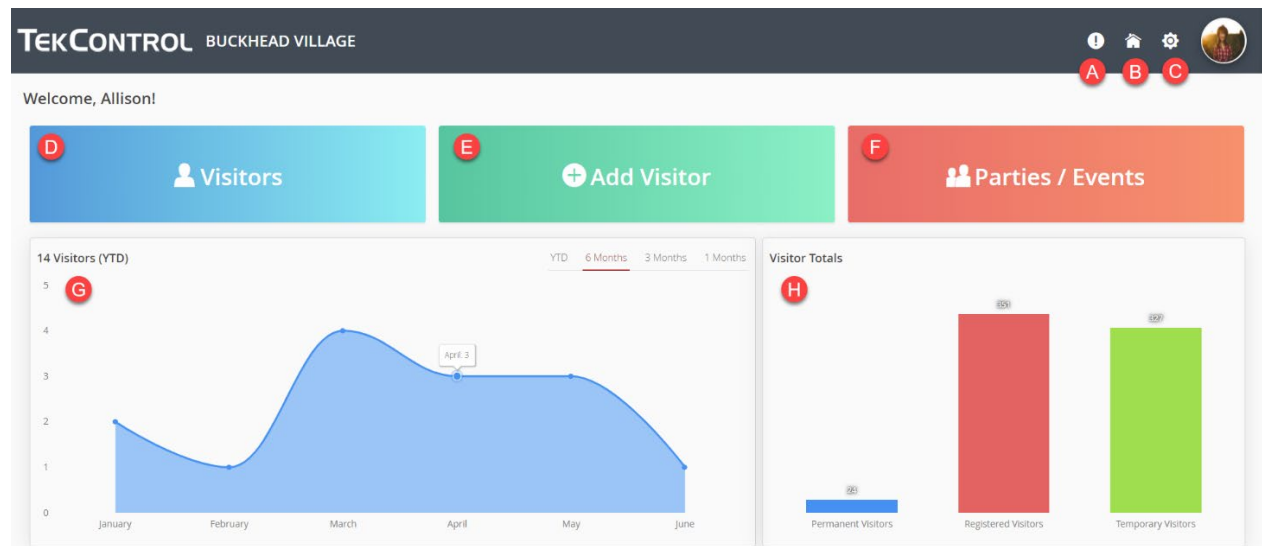

4. Visitors (D) – This is where you view visitors

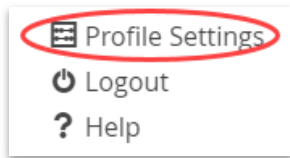
5. Add Visitor (E) – This is where you will add visitors

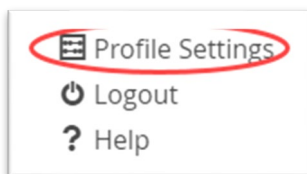
Figure 2: Address/Contact tab screenshot

 - a. Check this box if you want your guests to be able to call you from the directory to gain access (if applicable)
6. Directory Alias (C)
 - a. Enter a different name you would like listed under the directory

7. Directory Code (D)
 - a. This is the code your guests can enter to call you from the directory to gain access (if applicable)
8. Phone Numbers (E)
 - a. Update Phone numbers
 - b. Phone number can only be in the system once
9. Order – this is the order in which the guards will call, if needed
10. Notify (F)
 - a. If you want to get notifications of guests arriving you need to check this number
11. Directory (F)
 - a. This selects the number you want to be listed in the directory (if applicable)
12. Address Information (G)
 - a. This lists the properties that are assigned to you in the TEKControl System
13. Offsite Address (H)
 - a. If you have another offsite address you want listed, add it here
14. Emergency Contact (I)
 - a. Please list an emergency contact here
15. Click Save (J)

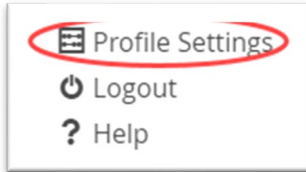

7. Registration (G) REQUIRED IF USING LICENSE PLATE RECOGNITION FOR ACCESS
 - a. Enter your license plate number
8. State (H)
 - a. Choose your state from the drop down
9. Click Save (I)

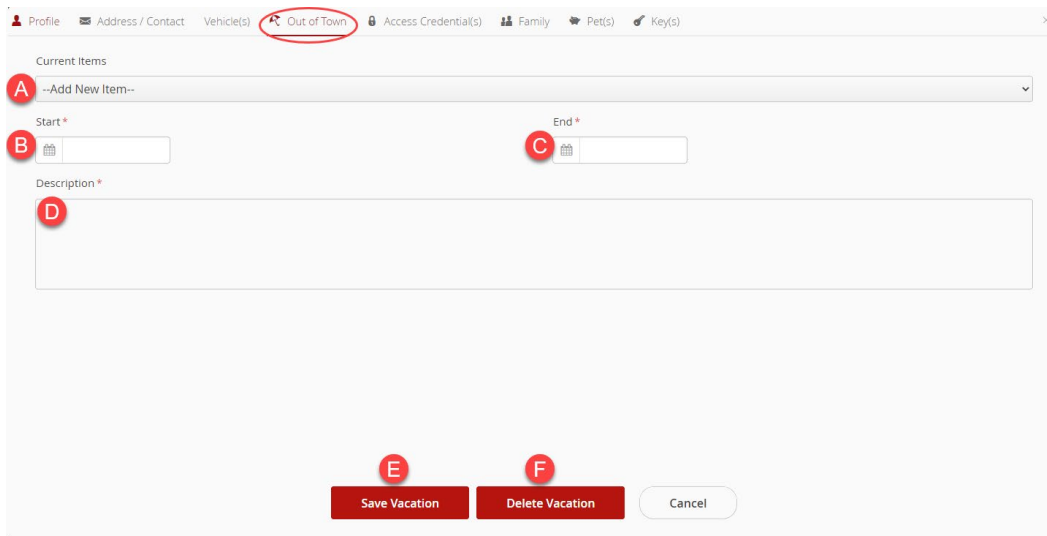


Figure 4: Out of Town screenshot

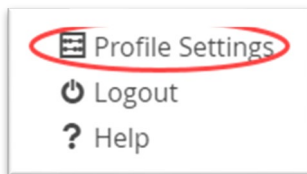

11. Enter Email address (I)
 - a. Required if you want the family member to have their own log in.
12. Date of Birth (J)
13. Directory Alias (K)
 - a. Enter an Alias if needed for the directory
14. Directory Listing (L)
 - a. Check if want this family member listed in the directory
15. Phone (M)
 - a. Enter phone number
 - b. REMEMBER: PHONE NUMBERS CAN ONLY BE IN THE SYSTEM ONCE**
16. Check Notify, if they want to receive notifications
17. Check Directory, if you want them to be listed in the directory
18. Notes (N)
 - a. Enter any notes for the guard to see
19. Notifications Opt-In (O)
 - a. Check and notifications you want the family member to receive

2. Enter visitor Last Name (B) – REQUIRED
3. Enter name of visitor Company (C) – if applicable
4. Select Destination from drop down (D) – REQUIRED
5. Additional Destination (E)
 - a. Rarely used
6. Select visitor Type from drop down (F) - REQUIRED
 - a. These fields are completely customized by your community
7. Select Host Property (G)
 - a. For residents with multiple properties, choose the property the visitor will go to

8. Schedule Date (H) – REQUIRED
 - a. Enter the date of Arrival for the visitor
9. Contact Email (I)
 - a. Enter the visitor Email
10. Visitor Expiration Date (J)
 - a. Enter the date the pass will expire
 - b. Pass limits are set by your community
11. Visitor phone number (K)
 - a. Cell number required if using E-Pass
 - b. Enter number with digits only, no space or dashes
12. Visitor Vehicle license plate number (L)
 - a. REQUIRED if your community uses license plate recognition for visitors
13. Key Authorized (M)
 - a. Check this box, if the visitor will be assigned a key, not common
14. Notes (N)
 - a. Enter any visitor notes
15. Click Save (O) or Save and Send E-Pass(P)

E-Pass: Some communities allow residents to send an email or SMS (text) message to their visitors to scan at the gate. The text will have your name and address with a link for them to click to get a pass on their phone

 - a. These fields are completely customized by your community
6. Schedule Date (H) – REQUIRED
 - a. Enter the date of Arrival for the visitor
 - b. Check this box, if the visitor will be assigned a key, not common

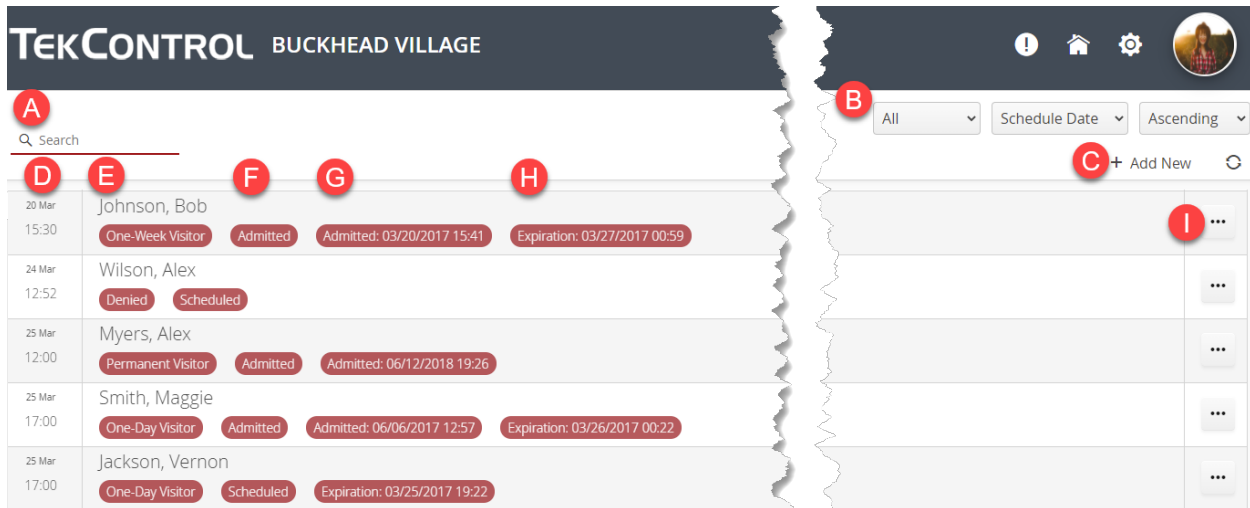
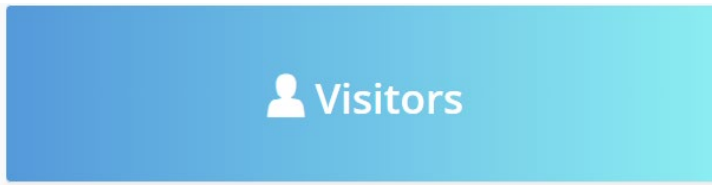
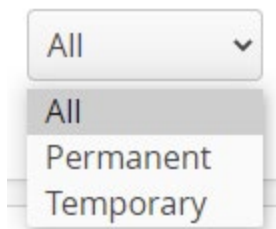


Figure 8: Visitor List screenshot

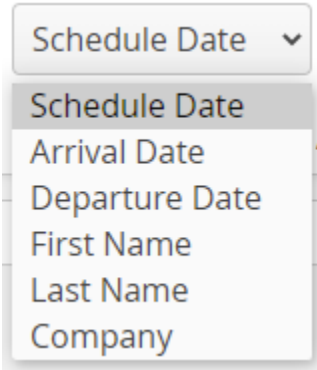

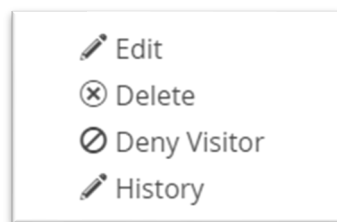

3. Click Add New (C) to add a visitor from the list screen
 - a. See Adding a Visitor for more info
 4. Scheduled Date (D)
 - a. This column is the date you scheduled the visitor
 5. Type of Visitor (E)
 - a. This is the type of visitor you chose when you added the visitor
 6. Status
 - a. This is the status of the visitor
 - i. Scheduled – you have scheduled them, but they have not arrived
 - ii. Arrived – visitor has visited at least once
 - iii. Denied – visitor has been denied
 - iv. Departed – visitor has departed
 7. Dates (G,H)
 - a. This shows the last admitted date and/or when their pass expires

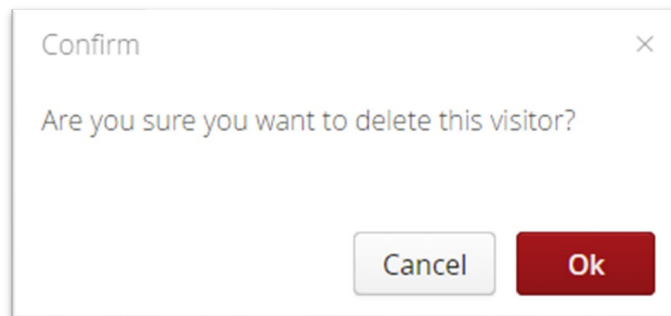

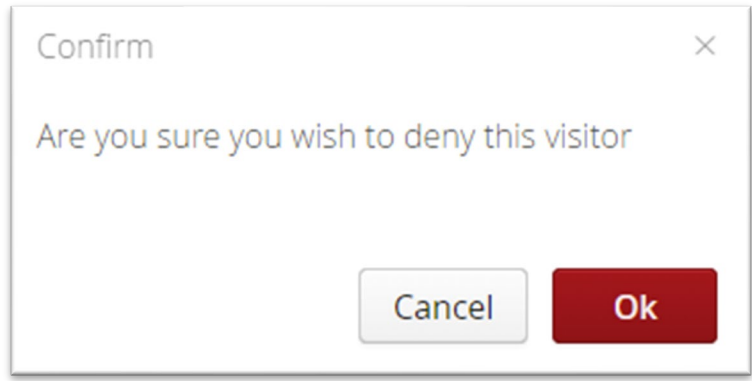

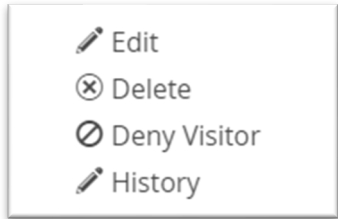

Parties/Events

Parties/Events are used to enter a lot of visitors, for a specific event, all at once.

1. Click the red Parties/Events button on the home page

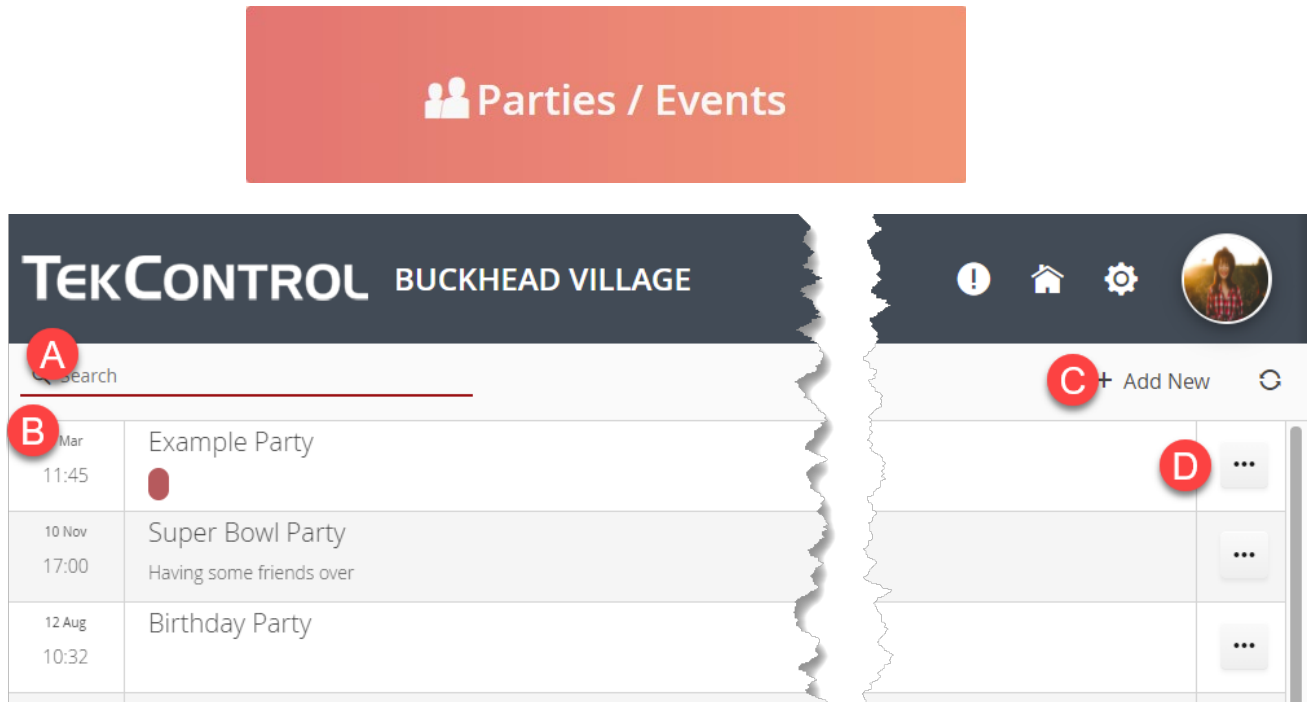


Figure 9: Parties/Events screenshot

Add a new Party/Event

1. Click Add New (C) – See Figure 9
 - a. Enter a name for the Party
 - b. Enter a Description for the party
 - c. Enter the start date and time
 - i. This defaults to the date you create the party, remember to change it to the actual party date
 - d. Enter the end date and time
 - e. Check if you only want to be notified for the first visitor
 - f. Enter the earliest time you want the visitors to be able to enter the gates
 - i. For example: The party starts at 7:30, you do not want a visitor before 7. Enter 30 in the box.
 - g. Click the drop down, to select a visitor from your current visitor list
 - i. Click Add Visitor (I)
 - h. Enter the First Name, Last Name, email and phone of a guest
 - i. Click Add Visitor
 - j. List of current people to be invited
 - k. To remove someone from the list, click Remove
 - l. Click Save to Save the party
 - m. Click Save and Send E-Pass to send an E-Pass to your visitors

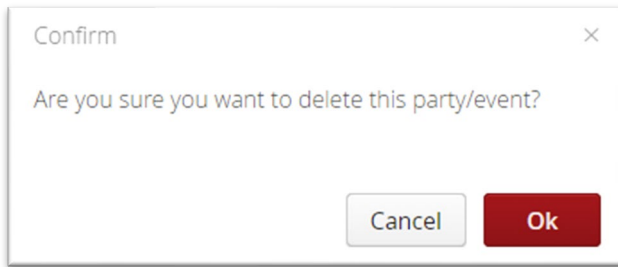

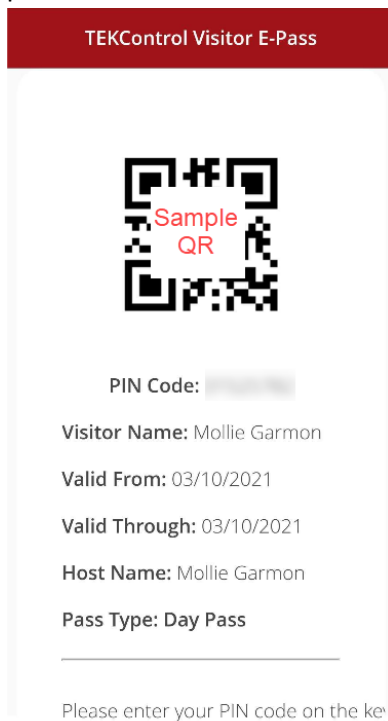

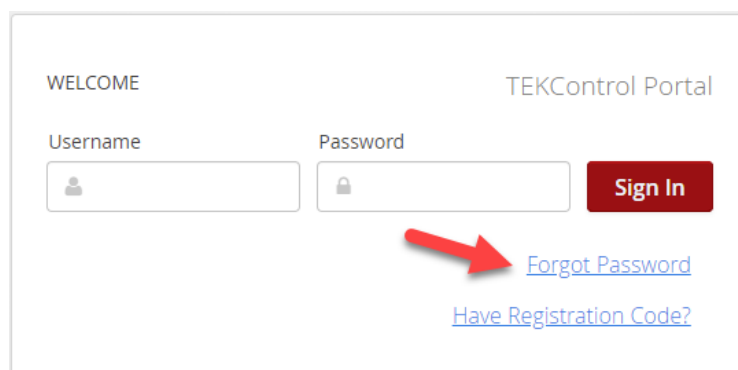
What is an E-Pass or QR code?

- Some communities allow residents to send an email or SMS (text) message to their visitors to scan at the gate. The text will have your name and address with a link for them to click to get a pass like the one below.



I forgot my password.

- You can reset your password on the log in page. Click the Forgot Password link on the login page. An email will be sent with instructions to reset your password. If you are still having problems, please reach out to your community contact.



I forgot my username.

- Your username is typically your email address. If that does not work, please reach out to your community contact.

I need to register for TEKControl.

- Please reach out to your community contact for registration.

I do not see the Save and Send ePass button.

- Not all communities allow the ePass function.

I cannot add my phone to my account.

- A phone number is only allowed in the system one time. Make sure you do not have the same number listed on a family members profile.
